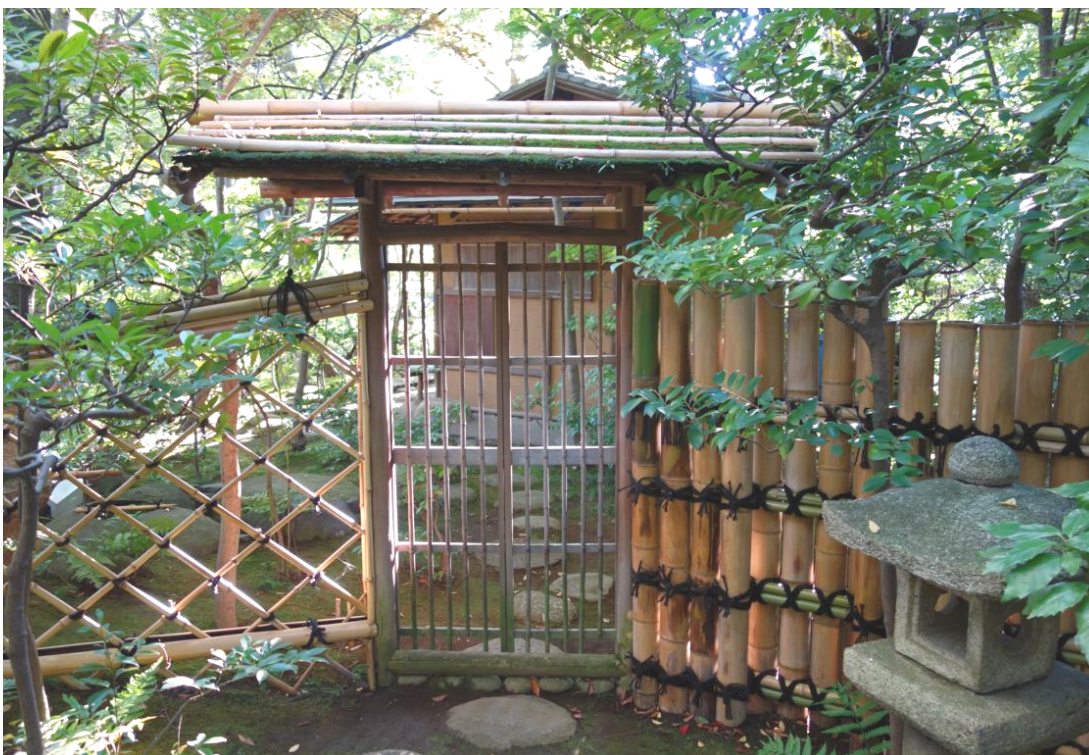
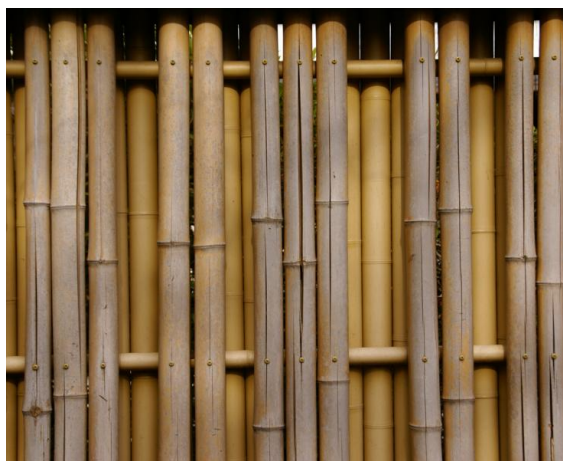
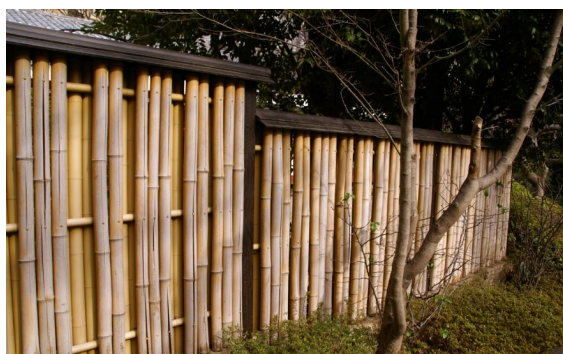




## Teppō-gaki

Whole bamboo poles are arranged in alternating groups on the front and back of a horizontal bar. They are fixed to the bar by nails or with decorative knots of "shuronawa", the traditional black twine. Some fences have a wooden frame, others are free-standing.
